ABA, or Applied Behaviour Analysis, is internationally regarded as the gold standard therapy in addressing autism. Based on the science of learning and behaviour, ABA is found to be the most helpful in building language and communication skills and social skills in children, improving their attention, focus, memory, and behavioural issues, while helping them to thrive academically. As Malaysia's largest 1:1 early intervention centre using ABA therapy, Autism Behavioral Center (ABC) has won multiple awards and is the top choice of families seeking intervention for their children who face challenges in communicating, learning and regulating their behaviour.

ABC implements PaTTAN (Pennsylvania Training and Technical Assistance Network) Technology, which was created by Dr. Amiris Dipuglia and Mr. Mike Miklos., and is directly supervised by a Board-Certified Behaviour Analyst (BCBA), Ms. Dita Chapman. The centre's main mission has always been to help children in their school readiness, while assisting them to acquire a more functional life, with a focus on managing their behaviour issues, speech delays as well as other challenges including social and emotional. The centre's international standards of intervention have been found to be exceptionally reliable, and have gained the trust of schools and doctors.
